Description: The overall objective of the project is the promotion of the artisanal sector: fishing villages, boats,

fishing gears, traditions and, in general, the local cultural values through the promotion of fishing as

a) identify and define, with the involvement of stakeholders, tourist, cultural and ethnographic generic and specific products for each fishing entity (cofradía/cooperative).

- d) develop possible tourist products for every fishing village
- e) create a distinctive brand for the artisanal fishermen of Gran Canaria.
- f) develop and launch a digital platform, as a main tool for the promotion of the fishing sector as a tourist and cultural value of Gran Canaria.
- g) develop and implement tools at the service of the local fishing sector that facilitate its adaptation to the administrative framework (both environmental and fishing aspects) of the activity.
- h) raise awareness about the importance of the application of the rules relating to minimum sizes.
- i) facilitate the application of the rules relating to the first sale of fishery products
- j) promote the correct performance of sustainable fishing activities and the respect to the marine environment
- k) promote the sustainability of recreational fisheries and the coexistence with the professionals l) improve the commercialization of products resulting from the good environmental practices.
