<i>Description:</i>	<p>The main objective of the initiative was to promote the production of high value fishery, value-added products, import substitution and export promotion in line with the goals of PRODESI (Programa de Apoio à Produção, Diversificação das Exportações e Substituição das Importações). Eight Value Chains (3 in fisheries, 2 in aquaculture, 1 in salt production, 1 in naval construction and maintenance and 1 in direct suppliers) were conducted in order to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Assess strengths and weaknesses.• Identify key business investors, private partners, associations or other linkages useful to doing business.• Identify key constraints and ways to overcome them.• Highlight gaps in forecasted regulatory targets and assess compliance risks and strategies.• Propose recommendations as to how highly ranked supply chains may be incorporated into the project activities.
